Council Chair proposed to discuss the agenda. No comments or objections were submitted by the members. The agenda was put to vote and adopted unanimously.

The following issues were discussed:

1. On the first agenda item the IGC Secretariat member Lianna Galstyan made a short review. Printed reports of the second Armenian Internet Governance Forum ArmIGF 2016 held on October 5, 2016 were distributed among IGC members and other participants of the meeting.
Lianna Galstyan is authorized to represent the IGC at IGF to be held in Guadalajara, Mexico on 6-9 December, 2016. It was suggested that on her return Ms. Galstyan make a report on participation to IGF.
2. Representatives of Kaspersky Laboratory made presentations speaking about the solutions or their company in the field of cybersecurity.
3. During the discussion it was noted that the legislative base and normative documents in the field of cybersecurity follow the development of the Internet, as a result the best practices-based approach is used. It was proposed to make a working and practical steps and form a Working Group involving the experts from Kaspersky Laboratory. The Working Group should offer a list of necessary human, software and technical resources for the creation of a state cybersecurity center, as well as offer suggestions for the development of approaches to cybersecurity concept.

Decisions:

1. To authorize Lianna Galstyan represent the IGC at IGF to be held in Guadalajara, Mexico on 6-9 December, 2016. At the next meeting Lianna Galstyan is to make a report on participation to IGF.
2. To form a Working Group involving the experts from Kaspersky Laboratory and Mr. Saghyan to offer a list of necessary human, software and technical resources for the creation of a state cybersecurity center, as well as offer suggestions for the development of approaches to cybersecurity concept by December 6, 2016.
